Renal disorders (Gout) occur in birds when uric acid levels become too high in their blood stream. All birds form uric acid and urate salts as a way of cleansing their bodies of the nitrogen-containing wastes that accumulate as they utilize the proteins in their foods. Birds do not normally produce much urine hence their blood uric acid passes out of their kidneys to form the thick, chalky-white urate crystals which surround the bird's stools and when uric acid levels get too high in the blood for any reason, the material comes out of solution and forms clumps of crystals in other parts of its body. These sharp crystals form around the joints and sometimes they form in the internal organs destroying them. This state is called Gout and the first form is called Articular gout and the second is known as Visceral gout.

How & Why is Uric Acid Produced?

All birds must consume protein and in the bird's digestive tract, these proteins are disassembled into amino acids and absorbed by its body. Some of these amino acids are re-assembled into the proteins that bird needs for growth and development when immature and for repairing tissue, creating new cells, enzymes, hormones, etc when it is an adult, but a large portion of the amino acids are burned in the bird's liver to produce energy (calories). When this occurs, the remaining nitrogen portion of the amino acids needs to be disposed of. The nitrogen, freed from these proteins is in the form of ammonia. Which is toxic hence birds convert this ammonia in to less-toxic uric acid. This uric acid is then eliminated through your bird's kidneys as Urates, the crystal salts of uric acid.

Benefits of UroCat Vet:

Acidifies urine and help to keep kidney stones dissolved & preserves functional renal mass of the affected area.

Prevents urinary deposits and hemorrhages in renal microlesions thereby preventing Visceral & Articular Gout.

Recommended Usage Levels of UroCat Vet:

For Prevention of Gout – Broilers – 3 to 5 ml / 100 birds per day for 3 to 5 days

Layers – 5 to 10 ml / 100 birds per day for 5 days

For Control of Gout – Broilers – 5 to 10 ml / 100 birds per day for 5 to 7 days

Layers - 20 ml / 100 birds per day for 5 to 7 days
